



How is Phys. Ed. done online?

Online Phys. Ed. means that students log their hours of activity and parents approve (in their online logbook) over a three week period. There are also online assignments and a leadership activity to be completed.

How many hours of activity do you need?

- 32 hours for 3 credits
- 64 hours for 5 credits

IS IT POSSIBLE TO TAKE MORE THAN ONE COURSE IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

If a student is taking a core course (Math, Science, Social, English) they will not be able to take a second course.

Classroom courses (Phys Ed, Religion): students can take more than one classroom based course as long as the dates don't overlap.

Online courses: Students taking online courses will only be approved to take a maximum of one core course, or two complimentary courses. If a student finishes their online courses with time left in the summer session, a Summer School Administrator may approve a third complimentary course.



CAMP HELA

Take Phys Ed and CALM (Earn 7 credits)
Only 22 students accepted. Register early!

Join us at Camp HeLa this summer to complete Phys. Ed. 10 and CALM 20 and earn seven High School credits. Begin your CALM 20 course and then attend Camp HeLa, a retreat west of Rocky Mountain House. Enjoy a variety of outdoor activities like canoeing, hiking and biking while earning credits for Phys. Ed. 10. This course is very popular with students entering grade 10.

Fee: \$575 camp fee

The fee for this program includes:

- Instruction on and off campus, transportation, meals, lodging and equipment.

Orientation course will be completed and online CALM course will begin.

Course can be finished early but no later than July 21, 2017
